Listed below are the products that may be sold and what is expected from our vendors.

Farmers:

- *Are allowed to sell what they grow, raise or produce.
- *May resell locally/regionally grown produce (NJ, NY or Eastern PA) is permitted but must be labelled as from another farm and include name & address of that farm.
- *May not purchase produce through Restaurant Depot or other large wholesale venues for resell.
- *Must keep receipts listing farm and location for resold produce so they will be available for inspection.
- *Produce must be fresh and high quality. Baked goods/prepared foods must be made from scratch using ingredients sourced from local/regional farms (fruit, dairy).

Guidelines for Listing Products

- Be specific. List ALL products you intend to sell. You will not be allowed to sell any products that are NOT listed. You may continue on the back of this page if necessary.
- Permission is given for one season only and must be applied for each season.
- Remain in your product category.
- **Produce** (including mushrooms, grain, etc.) - List all grown by you
Note: The following are abundantly available and may ONLY be used or sold when in season and sourced locally – tomatoes, corn, blueberries, strawberries, apples and peaches.
- **Animal Products** (Meat, poultry, eggs, wool, fleece, etc.) – List type and breed of animal and finished products.
- **Seafood** (wild-caught local fish and shellfish) – List docks and waters fished. Non local fish may not be sold.
- **Plants** (incl. cut flowers) - List products and location of greenhouse or field where grown.
- **Bee Products** (Honey, candles, soap) - List products.
- **Beverages** (Coffee, cider, fresh juices) - List products and source farm for juices and cider. List roasting location for coffee.
- **Preserves** (Jams, jellies) - List products and source farm where fruit/produce is grown
- **Baked Goods/Prepared Foods** – List products. If you plan to use any of the following ingredients, you must give source farms (name and location) for each: tomatoes, corn, blueberries, strawberries, apples and peaches.
Note: Must be made from scratch, no mixes, and using only locally-grown produce, if applicable (citrus, coffee, and other crops not grown locally may still be used). Regionally grown fruit must be used when available or frozen fresh fruit (from current season crop only).
