Apple Pie Contest Held at Summit Farmers Market October 9

SUMMIT, NJ, October 5, 2016 – The Summit Farmers Market will hold its second annual Apple Pie Contest this Sunday, October 9.

All amateur bakers are invited to bring their best apple pie to the market by 10:45AM. [Pre-registration is encouraged](#), but walk-ins are welcome! All types of apple pie are welcome: Dutch apple, caramel apple nut, apple crumb, etc. All components of the pie must be made from scratch. No canned fillings or premade crusts are allowed.

The pies will be judged on three criteria: crust, filling, and appearance by a panel of esteemed judges comprised of Donna Puzella, Dylan Baker, and Martin Kester. Donna Puzella is the owner of [Sweet Nothings](#), a candy and gift store in downtown Summit. Dylan Baker is a co-owner of [Summit House](#), the eagerly anticipated seasonal American restaurant and bar set to open later this year. Martin Kester is the Executive Chef of Summit House.

Winners will receive “Fun Money” that can be spent at the market and must provide his/her recipe to be shared in the Summit Farmers Market newsletter. After the pies are judged, they will be available for the public to sample.

Paul Fessock from [World of Rock: Music Lessons and More](#) will be DJing at the market this weekend. The Summit Farmer’s Market’s 20th Anniversary Cook Book will be available for purchase for \$10 each. The cookbook features deliciously simple recipes highlighting the fresh, seasonal ingredients available at the market.

The next Sunday Funday will be Pumpkin Painting on October 23 (rain date October 30). The market is located in Park & Shop Lot No. 2, at the corner of DeForest Avenue and Maple Street. The market is open from 8AM-1PM every Sunday through November 20.
