Judges Dylan Baker, Martin Kester, and Donna Puzella were given the challenging task of rating each pie on crust, filling, and appearance. Dylan Baker is a co-owner of [Summit House](#), the eagerly anticipated seasonal American restaurant and bar set to open early in 2017. Martin Kester will be the executive chef of Summit House. Donna Puzella is the owner of [Sweet Nothings](#), a candy and gift shop located at 26 Beechwood Road.

After deliberating, the judges crowned Megan Cunningham’s pie the winner. Megan, a Summit resident and pie enthusiast, entered the contest with her grandfather’s favorite apple pie recipe: Pop-Pop’s Caramel Apple Pie.
