### **Blueberry Pie Contest Held at Summit Farmers Market July 10**

SUMMIT, NJ, July 7, 2016 – The Summit Farmers Market will hold its second Blueberry Pie Contest this Sunday, July 10.

All amateur bakers are invited to bring their best blueberry pie to the market by 10:45AM. [Pre-registration is encouraged](#), but walk-ins are welcome! All dishes will be judged on three criteria: crust, filling, and appearance. All components of the pie must be made from scratch. No canned fillings or premade crusts are allowed. The panel of esteemed judges will be comprised of Bob Conway, Marin Mixon, and Kim Osterhoudt. Bob Conway is the owner of Brownie Points Bakery. Marin Mixon is the Executive Director of Summit Downtown, Inc. (SDI), the nonprofit responsible for running the market. Kim Osterhoudt is a locally renowned entrepreneur and the founder of Jams by Kim.

Winners will receive “Fun Money” that can be spent at the market and must provide his/her recipe to be shared in the Summit Farmers Market newsletter. After the pies are judged, they will be available for the public to sample.

The Summit Farmer’s Market’s 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Cook Book will be available for purchase for \$10 each. The cookbook features deliciously simple recipes highlighting the fresh, seasonal ingredients available at the market. Included in the book is last year’s first place blueberry pie recipe from Jozi Coates.

The next Sunday Funday will be a Salsa Contest on September 18. The market is located in Park & Shop Lot No. 2, at the corner of DeForest Avenue and Maple Street. The market is open from 8AM-1PM every Sunday through November 20.
