Summit Farmers Market Announces Addition of Four New Vendors

SUMMIT, NJ, April 11, 2016 – The Summit Farmers Market will begin its twenty-first season on Sunday, April 17. The market will be open every Sunday from 8AM to 1PM through November 20. The market is located in Park and Shop Lot No. 2, at the corner of DeForest Avenue and Maple Street. All downtown parking is free on Sunday, with convenient parking located in Park and Shop Lots 1 and 3 and the K Lot, located behind CVS.

Most of last year's vendors will be returning to the market. A full list of vendors can be found on summitfarmersmarket.com. The Summit Farmers Market is excited to announce the addition of four new vendors to the market: Boxwood Coffee, the Foraged Feast, Lakeside Maple Granola, and Maria's Gourmet Edibles.

[Boxwood Coffee](#) will sell a variety of seasonal hot and iced beverages including custom made coffee pour overs. Can't wait until the market starts? Visit their café in downtown Summit, located at 17 Beechwood Road. [The Foraged Feast](#), previously known as Dining Wild, will bring a variety of wild-foraged roots, nuts, berries, and mushrooms to the market. Look forward to everything from wild ramps to chicory and morels; offerings will vary based on what forager-in-chief Dan Lipow finds in the wild. [Lakeside Maple Granola](#) will be selling hand-crafted granolas and trail mixes made with high quality, delicious ingredients such as maple syrup, dried cranberries, almonds, and sunflower seeds. After ten successful years in business, Dawn from the beloved stuffed breads booth Mangia has decided to accept a new position as an education administrator, so the market is welcoming [Maria's Gourmet Edibles](#). Hailing from Lafayette, NJ, Maria will bring her delicious stuffed breads to the market including a spaghetti and meatballs stuffed bread, a vegan bread stuffed with broccoli rabe and other delicious veggies, and many other seasonal offerings.

Widely regarded as one of the area's best farmers markets, this will be the market's 21st year of providing fresh, locally-sourced food and produce to the Summit community. The Give It Fresh Today (G.I.F.T.) program will celebrate its 5th season at the market and continue to collect fresh food each week to donate to those in need.
