Summit Downtown Inc. Announces Addition of Six New Vendors to the Summit Farmers Market

SUMMIT, NJ, April 17, 2017 – The Summit Farmers Market will begin its twenty-second season on Sunday, April 23. Brought to the public by Summit Downtown Inc., the market will be open every Sunday from 8AM to 1PM through November 19. The market is located in Park and Shop Lot No. 2, at the corner of DeForest Avenue and Maple Street. All downtown parking is free on Sunday, with convenient parking available in Park and Shop Lots 1 and 3 and the K Lot, located behind CVS off Maple Street.

Most of last year's vendors will be returning to the market. A full list of vendors can be found on summitfarmersmarket.com. The Summit Farmers Market is excited to announce the addition of six new vendors: Anna Lee Herbs, Chickadee Creek Farm, Hummus Boss, Live Love Granola, and Patricia & Paul Artisans of Fine Oils and Balsamics.

- [Anna Lee Herbs](#) sells fresh herbs, organically grown in Mendham, dried herbs, herbal teas, flower essences, hydrosols, herbal salves, and more.
- [Chickadee Creek Farm](#) will be the market's new organic farmer and will sell a variety of organic vegetables, flowers, and fruits. An up-and-coming leader in the local farming scene, Chickadee Creek Farm was just named one of Edible Jersey's 2017 Local Heroes; you can find the article on page 34 of the [magazine's latest edition](#).
- [Hummus Boss](#), which many Summit patrons enjoyed at the Winter Farmers Market, will be at the Summer Farmers Market with his many types of hummus and Mediterranean dishes.
- [Live, Love, Granola](#) will be selling a wide variety of granolas, granola bars, and paleo options. Flavors include Cherry Pecan, Peanut butter, Monkey Mix, and Super Mix, which features quinoa, dried kale, and dried cranberries. Live Love Granola will be at the market every other week; Lakeside Maple, returning granola vendor, will alternate weeks with Live Love Granola.
