Summit Winter Farmers Market Announces Vendors

SUMMIT, NJ, December 21, 2016 – The Summit Winter Farmers Market will begin its inaugural season on Saturday, January 7, 2017. The Winter Farmers Market will be held every Saturday from 10am to 2pm through April 8, 2017 at Calvary Episcopal Church, located at 31 Woodland Avenue, at the corner of DeForest Avenue.

There will be 19 vendors at the Winter Farmers Market. Many of the vendors are perennial favorites from the Summer Market: Brownie Points Bakery, Ester's Treats, Gourmet Nuts and Dried Fruits, Hoboken Farms, Jams by Kim, Lakeside Maple Granola, Maria's Stuffed Breads, Nicola's Pasta Fresca, Paolo's Kitchen, Pickle Licious, Race Farm, Secret Garden Soap, Stefan's Specialty Foods, Tassot Apiaries, The Farmer and the Chickpea, and The Foraged Feast. New to the market are Gluten-Free Creations, Hummus Boss, and Poplar Wood Farm. Gluten-Free Creations bakes a variety of delicious gluten-free breads and rolls. Hummus Boss makes many different kinds of hummus and Middle Eastern dishes like baba ganouj. Poplar Wood Farm is an organic farm based out of Port Murray in Warren County, NJ.

Secret Garden Soap, Jams by Kim, Lakeside Maple Granola, and Ester's Treats will each be at the market every other week. Secret Garden Soap and Lakeside Maple Granola be at the market on January 7, while Jams by Kim and Ester's Treats will be at the market on January 14, and so on. The majority of the vendors will be indoors in the Parish Hall with Race Farm, Pickle Licious, and Poplar Wood Farm outdoors in the courtyard. The courtyard is accessible from Woodland Avenue or through Parish Hall.

Parking is conveniently available and free all day in the Calvary Church lot (enter from DeForest Avenue) and the K Lot (enter from Maple Street, behind CVS). The lots are adjoined, so it's very easy to walk from either lot to the market. Park and Shop Lot #1 is another option. The first hour of parking is free in all 3 Park & Shop Lots.

Come spend a Saturday in downtown Summit! Park for free, buy your fresh, high quality, locally produced products from the market, and enjoy all the wonderful shops, restaurants, fitness studios, and more in the downtown.
